

LEARN MORE ABOUT THE USF PUBLIC ART PROGRAM

The Public Art program at USF focuses on site responsive works, typically resulting in the creation of places, as opposed to objects. Most projects have been developed for the interjacent spaces between buildings, with footprints that result in plazas, gardens and courtyards. These projects serve as informal gathering spaces for the various academic neighborhoods of our campuses. Florida's Art in State Buildings Program was created legislatively in 1979, setting aside one half of one percent of any new state construction funds for the acquisition of artwork to be placed in and around our new facilities. At the University of South Florida, this program has allowed us to work with many of the nation's most prominent artists to develop public projects which enhance the aesthetics of our campus, and enrich the cultural life of our students, faculty and staff.
