Cartography: The science of making maps

Performance: An art form that combines visual art with dramatic performance

Installation: An artistic genre of three-dimensional works that often are site-specific and designed to transform the perception of a space

Colonial: Referring to the establishment of a [colony](#) in one territory by a political power from another territory, and the subsequent maintenance, expansion, and exploitation of that colony

Post Colonial: Referring to the period of time after colonization

Map: Defined as a representation, usually on a flat surface, of a whole or part of an area. The job of a map is to describe spatial relationships of specific features that the map aims to represent.

Embroidery: The handicraft of decorating fabric or other materials with needle and thread or yarn

Tapestry: A form of textile art, traditionally woven on a vertical loom
